What is the IAA?

- An association of actuarial associations around the world
- To be a member association, an actuarial organization must comply with certain requirements



The Role of the IAA

What professional requirements does the IAA place on its member associations?

- A Code of Conduct containing certain specific provisions
- A disciplinary process that protects the public as well as the rights of the actuary
- A minimum education requirement
