



## ASTIN Board Meeting – Zoom Call

09 November 2022

1. Actuvieview (30 min: Martin Oymanns/all)

Martin Oymanns from the DAV gave a brief history of actuvieview also mentioning the partners, number of recorded events. Participants are able to benefit by publishing, promoting, getting access to specific target groups and actuteam challenge.

The slides Martin presented contain number of videos and users; half of the users are receiving the newsletter. Membership benefits could be promoting content, use it as a news channel, communicate/announce activities like webinars which is for example relevant for ASTIN.

actuvieview started in 2019 which especially means a short history w/o Corona. It might be also of advantage for risk managers and banking people. A lot of views are there in August, but comparatively low in Oct/Nov. Currently the search options are up for improvement; a split by year and topic should be enabled.

Slides for download are available. Content in Spanish is possible which would be in line with the approach to intensify ASTIN presence in LATAM.

There will be an online conference from Sept 19 to 23 next year which can be provided with content from all around the globe.

Martin will function as a contact person for ASTIN regarding further input and discussion.

2. New course ASTIN academy (20 min: Miyuki/Jed)

Jed was presenting some slides referring to the status. With respect to the headline what can we do better it was mentioned to involve more contributors from industry. A Spanish version of the course will be available on rather short notice which could also help to increase membership in LATAM. ASTIN is also able and willing to support translations financially. Jed and Chema will be in contact and the latter one especially with the professors in Barcelona who provided the translation into Spanish as there might be an option to generate more learning material in Spanish.
