FINAL CHAPTER TOKYO

Article 8: Finals

The 4 finalists shall be invited to give a 5-minute presentation on the stage of ICA 2026 on November 10, 2026 during a plenary session in Tokyo. These presentations will be followed by questions from the attendees.

Based on the quality of the presentations and answers, as well as the overall impression from the prior rounds, the winner will be voted on by the following parties:

- YAWC 2026 Jury (25% weight)
- ICA 2026 attendees (25% weight)
- IAA Leadership Team (25% weight)
- YAWC 2026 Participants (25% weight)

Finalists Sequence

To enhance visibility of the competition and engage the global actuarial community, each finalist must publish a LinkedIn post prior to the finals.

The post should highlight (not necessarily in this order):

- The journey to the finals
- The importance of competition for young actuaries
- The topic and key highlights
- A call-to-action encouraging colleagues and peers to support by liking the post
- Date and time of the Finals session
- The link or YouTube video
- Official hashtags: #YAWC #YoungActuariesWorldCup #ICA2026 #IAJ #IAA

The number of LinkedIn likes recorded at 10:00 a.m. ET on September 15, 2026 will determine the order of presentations:

- Most likes: First choice of presentation order
- Second most likes: Second choice
- Third most likes: Third choice



Presentations

Presentations must relate to the initial video and may not exceed 5 minutes. Slide support is optional, but if slides are used, they must be submitted by September 15, 2026, 10:00 a.m. ET.



Questions

Each finalist will be asked one question by a panel of four VIP judges. Finalists will have 2 minutes to respond.



Judging

Attendees will vote for their preferred finalist based on the quality of the presentations and answers. Prior exposure to the initial videos or earlier webinar rounds may also be considered.

Additionally, each VIP judge will cast a vote. Each VIP vote will increase the audience score by 5 percentage points (e.g., 25% increases to 30%).

World Champion

The winner will be announced during the plenary session and invited on stage to receive the prestigious IAA YAWC Trophy from the IAA President.

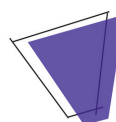
